Two years after he was diagnosed with bipolar disorder, 19 year old Kevin Hines attempted to take his life by jumping from the Golden Gate Bridge. He is one of only 34 to survive the fall, and the only one to regain full physical mobility.

Today, Kevin dedicates his life to saving lives by spreading a message of hope and sharing his ways of living mentally well.
